WHAT WE DO



PRABU HAD A ROUGH START IN LIFE.

After his father was violently murdered, Prabu and his impoverished mother were left to fend for themselves in rural India. Opportunities were scarce. Prabu's mother took him to the REACH school in



Kodimangalam where Prabu was able to receive nine years of free, high-quality education. Prabu went on to college and graduate school. Today, Prabu is the administrator of the REACH school where he got his chance.

PRABU'S SUCCESS IS WHAT REACH INTERNATIONAL IS ALL ABOUT.

REACH International runs schools, orphanages and assistance centers in 24 developing countries across the globe.

Thousands of disadvantaged and needy children—regardless of their race, gender, ethnicity or religion—are getting a chance to break out of poverty.

- In Burkina Faso, 900 children receive an education in 18 schools, some of which also provide life-saving feeding programs.
- In Honduras, two schools serve 500 children K-12; and 64 children have a home at our orphanage.
- In India, we have four schools helping to educate 500 disadvantaged children.
- In Kenya, we operate three orphanages, providing a safe start for these vulnerable children, and an elementary school.
- In Mali, 600 students in four schools receive an education, and we also provide them clothing, food, and school supplies.
